...Who are making a survey in dangerous Indian territory have been out of contact with their base for over 24 hours.

The missionary Aviation Fellowship plane that flew the men has been spotted from the air on riverbank and appears to be damaged beyond repair. No signs of life of any kind can be seen around the plane. Ground and air searching parties have been organized by both missionary and military forces, but as yet no reports of locating the five missionaries have come in.

Prayer is urgently requested for the safety and early rescue of the following missionary colleagues: Nate Saint of Missionary Aviation Fellowship, Ed McCully, Jim Elliot, and Peter Fleming, all of Christian Missions in Many Lands, and Roger Youderian of the Gospel Missionary Union.
