On behalf of the five courageous widows and the nine fatherless children, Stephen, Michael and Matthew Jay McCully; Beth Elain and Jerry Youderian; Valerie Elliot; and Kathy, Stephen and Philip Saint, thank you again for your gracious and generous gift to this Fund. You will be interested to know that this martyrdom has stirred world-wide attention and compassion, so that gifts have come from the Far East, Latin America, Africa, and Europe, as well as from the United States and Canada.

At the moment of this writing the Fund has passed \$50,000; and contributions continue to come from sympathetic hearts far and near. The trustees have conferred with the widows, and have agreed upon these objectives for the Fund:

1. To meet the immediate needs, if any...
2. To provide for any emergencies that may arise, such as surgery and hospitalization, for mothers and children...
3. To provide for the education of the children in years to come, with the hope that they will be servants of God to their fellow-men--as were their fathers.

The Fund is not compiling a mailing list and does not intend to send appeals for additional funds. More help may be needed for these very worthy widows and children, and further gifts for the Fund will be gratefully received and prayerfully used.
