Please send your application to the Registrar with the Room Reservation Blank, the Health Examination Form filled out by your physician, a small photo or clear snapshot (at least two by three inches), and a remittance to cover the advance registration deposit of \$25.00. The three Recommendation Forms should be signed and handed to the proper individuals with the request that they be filled out immediately and mailed directly to the Registrar. If you have not been employed, the third recommendation form may be filled out by any business acquaintance.

A student transferring from another institution should request a letter of recommendation from the dean or some other official, in addition to a transcript of credits.

All applicants are required to submit in their own words and handwriting a brief autobiography of 500 words or less in which they shall include their reasons for wishing to attend Wheaton College.
